

SOPHIE RYDER

(Née/Born 1963)

Sophie Ryder est née à Londres en 1963. Elle étudie les arts aux Royal Academy Schools. C'est en poursuivant ses études en peinture qu'elle est encouragée par ses professeurs à développer ses talents de sculpteur. Inspirée par Goya, Picasso et Moore, elle présente en 1986 ses sculptures avec grand succès à la foire internationale de Zurich. Son langage sculptural est principalement composé d'animaux. Toutefois, elle évite habilement l'illustration anecdotique qu'on retrouve souvent dans l'art animalier. Les dimensions de son travail varient entre l'intime et le monumental. Elle préconise l'utilisation du fil de fer pour assembler des compositions libres qui évoquent le mouvement. Elle vit et travaille dans la région de Gloucestershire en Angleterre.

Sophie Ryder was born in London in 1963. She studied combined arts at the Royal Academy Schools and while obtaining her diploma in painting, was encouraged by teaching artists to develop her sculpture. Inspired by Goya, Picasso and Henry Moore she first presented work at the Zurich Art Fair in 1986 and was an immediate success. She is a sculptor whose chosen vernacular is the animal form, although she is not in any ordinary sense an animal artist. Her works range in scale from small to monumental, in both compelling bronzes and formed and bent wire loosely composed and always in motion. Sophie Ryder lives in the heart of the Gloucestershire countryside with her family.
