Concrete and Steel Structure with Mosaic. 16' x 20', nationwide project.
- 2007 *Portrait of Charlotte Jewish Day School and Temple Israel Religious School*, The Foundation of Shalom Park, Charlotte, NC. Two 12' x 18' collage and acrylic on canvas paintings depicting portraits of children of the two schools, grades K-8.

Rouso was commissioned to produce five works of art for the new NBA Bobcats Basketball Arena in Charlotte, NC on an incredibly short deadline.
The Quilt
Rouso held an open call inviting local Charlotteans to have their photo taken to be a part of *The Quilt*. This illustrates how the center of the textile industry has now become a quilt of faces from all backgrounds.
Charlotte Bobcats
An original painting of the players of this NBA basketball team.
Charlotte Wall
Depicts the images of hometown companies and icons associated with Charlotte during the 20th century.
Charlottetowne, North Carolina
This piece illustrates the history of Charlotte from its humble beginnings in 1755.
Queen Charlotte
This is the artist's impression of Queen Charlotte's disdain for her namesake city.
- 1995 *Swimmers*, Charlotte Aquatic Center - Arts and Science Council, NC. A 75' x 12' mural was painted prior to the pre-Olympic trials held at this aquatic facility.
- 1994 *Home Movies*, Charlotte Convention Center - Arts and Science Council, NC.
